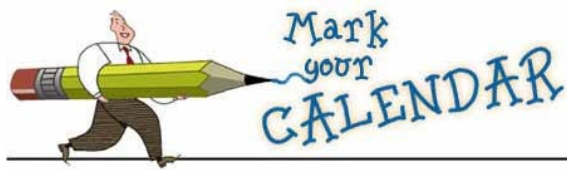
Book Club for Young Readers
